CHANGES TO KITCHENER'S GARBAGE COLLECTION PROGRAM

How this will affect St. Mark's Church...

As most of you know, starting in March, homes will be limited in the amount of garbage they can place at the curb for regional pickup.

While blue boxes and green boxes will continue to be picked up weekly, free garbage pick-up will now be limited to 4 bags every two weeks, with additional bags being charged a \$2 fee per bag. St. Mark's – even though we are a large facility and not a private residence – will be bound by these SAME restrictions.

Presumably this will present a challenge, especially when we are faced with larger events (like funerals, pancake suppers, etc.) where the amount of garbage produced is greatly increased.

Please watch the bulletin in the coming weeks for information and education on changes we will be making as a parish in order to step up to this challenge.

For the most part this change will affect ALL of us, but with a little careful organization and everyone's co-operation, we can rewire the way we think about and deal with waste! *Stay tuned*!
