We should be curious about our eternal homeland. An interesting book to read on the topic is "Everything You Ever Wanted To Know About Heaven... But Never Dreamed of Asking" by Peter Kreeft. Saint Augustine remarked about heaven as being where we are forever satisfied and forever thirsty. "Never tired; never bored; never wanting except for more." (Fr. Don Sanvido)


