Such attraction fades quickly - it cannot compete in the market of leisure pursuits, incorporating as it increasingly does various forms of religious titillation." (Pope Benedict XVI)

To be sure, our Holy Father has more on his mind than this. I don't think he wants us to check our joyful spirit at the doors of the church, nor cease to applaud at appropriate times, like when we announce newlyweds. Nevertheless, the sacred liturgy must impact us in such a way as to uplift the Lord and the worship of the Holy Trinity.

I thank you for your devotion and reverence, especially before and in preparation for Mass. Let us gather in prayer that we may increasingly enter the profound mysteries of faith.
