Gr. 2 FIRST COMMUNION ~ 2017 Catechism Program

Optional but highly recommended for all Grade 2 students preparing to receive First Holy Communion at St. Mark's Parish in 2017 (*for all schools but especially for public school students*).

The Sisters of Our Lady Immaculate will lead an excellent 8-week program for First Communion & First Reconciliation here at St. Mark's Parish on Tuesday evenings starting in March. Gr. 7 CONFIRMATION ~ 2017 Preparation Sessions

Required for all Grade 7 students preparing to be confirmed at St. Mark's Parish in 2017 (*regardless of school affiliation*)

As part of the preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation, Fr.
