#### Blessing of Throats: Feb. 1 & 2

Following each Mass next weekend, Fr. Don and Deacon Basil will bless throats. This traditional blessing is connected with the Feast of St. Blaise, a bishop and martyr of the Church. All may receive this blessing if they so choose. The blessing goes as follows: "Through the intercession of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, may you be delivered from all ailments of the throat and from all other evil, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen."

#### Famous Catholic Prayers (PART 3)

The following prayer, called the Morning Offering, is used to begin our day. The Christian meaning of the word 'offer' is to exchange something less or lower for something more or greater. We may complain about our aches and pains or we may offer them up – exchanging complaint for compassion, understanding or a unity with Jesus' own sufferings. The following prayer calls us to unite our whole day and our experiences that day to Christ's redemptive work in union with the Church, God's people, and the success of St. Peter (the Pope).

#### The Morning Offering

Dear Lord, I offer you all my prayers, works, joys and sufferings of this day. In union with the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass throughout the world, in reparation for all my sins, for the intentions of all my associates (be they family, friend, neighbor, etc.) and, in particular, for the Holy Father in Rome.
