

Gr. 7 Confirmation Preparation Sessions for 2016

Required for all Grade 7 students preparing to be confirmed at St. Mark's Parish in 2016, regardless of school affiliation.

As part of the preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation, Fr. Don will hold 6 Sunday sessions for candidates, sponsors (if possible) and parents following the 11:30 Masses (take a 10-minute break after Mass and reassemble in the church for 12:45 p.m. – this way, you can come to Mass without having to return to the church during the week for these sessions). Remember to be present at Mass each and every Sunday as well as for these sessions.

These mandatory sessions provide an opportunity to learn more about our faith so that Confirmation itself will be a truly meaningful celebration of the sacrament. Listed below are the dates, times and topics to be covered:
