Gr. 7 CONFIRMATION ~ 2017 Preparation Sessions

Required for all Grade 7 students preparing to be confirmed at St. Mark's Parish in 2015 (regardless of school affiliation)

As part of the preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation, Fr. Don will hold 6 Sunday sessions for candidates, sponsors (if possible) and parents following the 11:30 Masses (take a 10-minute break after Mass and reassemble in the church for 12:45 p.m. - this way, you can come to Mass without having to return to the church during the week for these sessions). Remember to be present at Mass each and every Sunday as well as for these sessions. These mandatory sessions provide an opportunity to learn more about our faith so that Confirmation itself will be a truly meaningful celebration of the sacrament.

Sessions take place on the following Sunday Afternoons from 12:45 to 1:30 pm: Feb. 5, 19, March 5, 19, April 2, 23

PARENTING TIP OF THE MONTH

At Christmas it is easy for children to get so wrapped up in what they want that they forget the reason for the season: the birth of Christ. Jesus came to offer a great sacrifice - his life so our sins could be forgiven. He taught us to look toward others; to feed the hungry, care of the sick and so much more. He invites each spouse to see their married love as love that must be first and fore-most self-giving. The Pope is reminding us that love may not be perfect, but it is love and when we nurture it from within, we strengthen and build a deep bond between us.
