

### **Famous Catholic Prayers**

Here's a new section to our bulletin – if not weekly, at least on a regular basis...

'Famous' is an unusual word to describe prayer – 'deep', 'profound', 'inspirational' are more likely terms. The idea came from a man who remarked at a funeral committal service that few Catholics knew the responses to my invocation "Eternal rest grant unto him, O Lord ..." He was surprised this 'famous' Catholic prayer has fallen into disuse. This is the case, I'm afraid, with so many of our beautiful formal Catholic prayers. So, I'll put many in the bulletin and hopefully we can have families pray them again and teach them to their children. While spontaneous prayers are good and often a sign of a well-developed spiritual life, formal prayers form a solid, theological base for our more 'personal' prayer. So, we will begin. Keep an eye open in the bulletin for them. Let us re-learn our simple and beautiful prayers – those that have sustained the faith for centuries.

### THE SIGN OF THE CROSS

(touching the forehead with the right hand)
"In the name of the Father,"

(then the chest, close to the heart)

"and of the Son,"

(then the left and right shoulders, in that order)

"and of the Holy Spirit. Amen."

The Father sent down His Son to the core of our humanity. Through His cross we have been saved from the left, sinister darkside, to the right (or righteous, good side).

Begin and end the day, and all prayer, with the Sign of the Cross. Make it when passing a Catholic church which houses the Eucharist; make it when passing a cemetery to remember Christ's victory over sin and death; make it when encountering an emergency vehicle, praying for those in need; most especially make it in times of temptation — Christ's saving cross bars the way to hell. Pray! Talk to God! Listen to Him! - Fr. Don
