Dear People of St. Mark's Parish,

At the end of June I will begin a 3-month sabbatical from official priestly duties. Our diocese allows us to take one after the completion of 13 years of service. Now, after 39 years of parish life, I will be taking one from July 1st to September 26th. The reasons for my sabbatical are for small health purposes, extended personal time for prayer and study, and to take care of some personal matters.

I thank the Bishop for granting me this opportunity. He personally told me not to preach, cover for other priests or make any definitive plans to go here or there during this time. The things I need to do I will do during that period when I am free from official pastoral duties. That is what the extended days of leave give me time to do – sort things out.

Most definitely, I will keep in touch with Pam, Deacon Basil and my replacement, Fr. Jason Catania. To be sure, I will be informed of anything big that comes up. Though I will not be able to return for funerals and the like, I will want to know about them so that I can personally contact and pray for the bereaved and the deceased. I wish to thank our Bishop for allowing me to take this sabbatical – actually, he encouraged me to do so. From time to time I am to contact him and let him know, generally speaking, what I am up to. Since the parish golf tournament is toward the end of my period away, and I will be back in the area, I plan to take it in. That will be an enjoyable day for me.

Now about my replacement: Father Jason Catania is from Baltimore and he has been in our city and diocese for only a brief period of time. How he came to be a priest in this diocese is an interesting story that he should share with you. Father has most graciously consented to take my place and officially he will be the administrator of the parish in my absence. Essentially, that means that he will sign the cheques and make any necessary decisions. He will be celebrating all the weekday and weekend Masses. There will be a few exceptions to the usual schedule, for instance, there will not be a Monday morning Mass, nor will there be a daily Mass on the days when he has to celebrate Mass at one of our nursing homes. Other than that, the ship will float per usual. I know you will warmly welcome Father and receive him as well as you have received me.

I certainly will miss the parish, and I'll be tempted to come back early, but I cannot, so the Bishop advises. So I head out after the 9:00 a.m. Mass on Wednesday, July 1st (Canada Day). My first stop – the cemetery to visit my dad and loved ones.

Keep me in your prayers so that I don't get into any serious trouble. I wish everyone a pleasant and safe summer. See you in September.
