ANNUAL NOVENA TO ST. ANNE

St. Ann's Church, 120 Sherman Ave. N. (at Barton), Hamilton.
Thursday, July 18th to Friday, July 26th (Feast of St. Anne) Each day (including Saturday & Sunday) at 7pm we will have Mass, novena prayers, homily and blessing with the relic of St. Ann as well as confessions following the Mass with the exception of the concluding Mass. The homilist will be Father Joseph Durkacz, pastor of St. Ann's in Hamilton. Most Reverend Anthony F. Tonnos, D.D., Bishop Emeritus of Hamilton will celebrate the concluding Mass on Friday, July 26th at 7pm. All are welcome to this longstanding and blessed event that has been taking place for over 100 years.

A note from Fr. Don... *"This is the oldest and certainly one of the most active public Novenas in North America. The novena consists of 9 days of Masses with particular emphasis on asking St. Anne to intercede for our requests for physical, spiritual and moral healing. During the novena, special homilies are given each night, special intercessory prayers and veneration of the relic of St. Anne. Two evenings are reserved for the sacraments of penance and the anointing of the sick. Schedules are available the first evening of the novena. This is, I believe, the novena "par excellence" – healings, blessings, graces practically bouncing off the walls of the church into any willing soul.*

TIPS: *Dress modestly but with light clothing, as it is usually 'quite warm' in the church. Bring water with you. Get there early to find a parking spot. Come with prayer for yourself and others. St. Ann's Church is a 1-hour easy drive from West Kitchener."*
