Parish Update....

This Sunday begins the summer schedule for the bulletin and the next bulletin will not be published until the first weekend in August before returning to the normal schedule on Labor Day Weekend. With school out this week, it also means the beginning of summer vacations, and before we disperse, here are a few updates on the Parish.

Parish Council

The new parish council consists of Doug Behl, Linda Blake, Rick Denomme, Tom Germann, Ian Kangaloo, Cathy Voisin, Beth Seaward, Marilyn Dufresne and myself.

It has been many years since the parish has had a parish council and since February the group has met on 5 different occasions to discuss their purpose as a Pastoral (parish) Council whose mandate is to "engage in the pastoral care of the of the parish." In other words, they help the parish priest in carrying out the pastoral direction of the parish.

Meetings of the Parish Council have basically consisted of discussions centering on the parish: past, present and future and its strengths and opportunities. Many ideas were generated for consideration such as youth ministry and outreach; importance of building a welcoming community; parish retreat days and faith development; topics of finance and fund raising; community building and social events; Sunday children's liturgy of the word, RCIA and Scripture studies program; volunteer parish BBQ, and topics centering around our Sunday Eucharist and other liturgical and praise and worship services. These are just some of the topics that the parish council has identified and more topics will evolve over time. In the Fall, when meetings of the parish council resume, we hope to develop some pastoral action plan to start developing some of these key areas of parish life.

Parish Finance

Parking Lot – Repairs to the parking lot were completed at a cost of \$6,376.00. To help lengthen the life of the pavement, the parish is looking into a service contract with the paving company to compete regular maintenance on the lot.

Snow Clearing – Last season from November to April, the parish paid closed to \$25,000.00 (tax included) for snow clearing and salting services. This amount obviously ate into the operating budget for the parish and this year we have decided to use another contractor. Rather than pay per visit, the new contact will be a seasonal fixed amount of \$14,000.00. The contract will be signed for a one-year period.

Mortgage – Total amount still owing on the mortgage is \$566,668.47

Diocesan Capital Campaign

At the request of Bishop Crosby, every parish in the Diocese has been asked to participate in a Capital Campaign. Basically, through a 3-year pledge program from parishioners, each parish has been asked to raise the amount of their <u>2017</u> yearly collection. In our case, that amount is approximately \$280,000.00.

Information on this has been published throughout the year in the bulletin and you can learn more about it by visiting https://www.oneheartonesoul.ca or https://hamiltondiocese.com/campaign. Parishes in the Diocese have different start dates, and the date for St. Mark is the weekend of September 23-24, 2019. The parish is in the process of preparing for the program, which includes developing teams of volunteers who will help in this process. If you are particularly interested in learning more about this or helping out, please let me know or contact Pam at the office.

Sacraments

This year the number for the Sacrament of Confirmation was 53 and for the Sacrament of First Eucharist, 59.

Offertory Report in the Bulletin

Starting this week the offertory collection is being reported in a new format in the bulletin. The changes will now include a weekly budget amount or goal for the Sunday Offertory Collection, as well as, a year to date report. As reported in this week's bulletin, a weekly budget of \$5,200.00 has been identified to cover the basic operational expenses of the parish and last week's offering of 4,042.81 meant that there was a shortfall of \$1,157.19 for that one week.

The next section below the Weekly Report is the Yearly Report to date and as reported we are currently in the red by \$18,846.24.

It is important that we get our collections up to meet our weekly budget of \$5,200. Each summer the collections decrease because of people away on holidays. Even if you are away from the parish, please remember the parish in your weekly offering or consider signing up to direct deposit.
