Important Information on Assisted Suicide/Dying

As you are likely aware, Canada's Special Joint Committee on Physician-Assisted Dying released its report to the government with its recommendations on how to proceed with legislation on this issue. Many groups and organizations are alarmed at the recommendations (as they go far beyond what the Supreme Court mandated for the new law) and have produced excellent statements in response. Cardinal Thomas Collins has released a video on the topic to help educate people as well. Both the video and many of the statements can be found on the website of the Hamilton Diocese: www.hamiltondiocese.com/offices/familyministry/assisted-suicide-2016. You are encouraged to watch Cardinal Collins' video and read the documents. For your convenience, a statement from the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops is inserted in today's bulletin, with an article written by Cardinal Thomas Collins printed on the back. Once the legislation is written and passed into law, changing it will not be easy since it will require a constitutional challenge. Now is the time for us to react and speak to our Members of Parliament about the new law. Praying for all those in a decision making position is essential, but so is having our voices heard.
