Good Friday: a day of fasting and abstinence

This week we will celebrate Good Friday, which is a day of fasting and abstinence. There are only two days of fasting and abstinence prescribed by the Church: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday (Code of Canon Law #1251).

FASTING means eating less than normal. We are asked to eat one regular size meal and two smaller meals. Catholics between the ages of 16-60 are asked abide by this discipline.

ABSTINENCE means abstaining from eating meat on this day. Catholics older than 14 years of age are asked to abide by this discipline.

Each year, the bishop invites those who are baptized or received into the full communion of the Catholic Church to a celebration of the Eucharist at the Cathedral of Christ the King in Hamilton. This year's celebration will take place on **Sunday, April 7 at 4:00 p.m.** All are invited to participate in this special liturgy as a sign of welcome to the newest members of Christ's Body in our Diocese of Hamilton.


