Famous Catholic Prayers (PART 12)

Each of the seven sacraments have an 'outward sign' that both effects (causes) and brings to mind the spiritual reality that takes place.

For instance, the **water** used in Baptism cleanses us spiritually through the power of the Holy Spirit. The Spirit 'uses' water to forgive sin and bring forth God's life within us. We would not, however, say that the water (the sign) *becomes* God. Nor would we say that the **oil** used in Confirmation becomes God.

What makes the **Eucharist** so unique is that the outward signs (bread and wine), once consecrated, do in fact *become* Jesus Christ. That is why the Eucharist alone is called the <u>Most Blessed</u> Sacrament. This ancient prayer brings this to mind:

The Most Blessed Sacrament

Praise, adoration and thanksgiving be to our Savior, Jesus Christ, in the Most Blessed Sacrament of the altar.

How long does the physical presence of Jesus' body and blood remain in our bodies? The Church teaches that He physically remains for as long as the external properties of 'breadness' and 'wineness' remain. Obviously, the physical aspect of His body and blood remain only for a short while in our bodies. However, the spirit of Christ and the grace of the sacrament can live indefinitely in us – depending on our love and obedience. We weak mortals need God's <u>daily</u> bread to eat and are privileged to have it in full view on the altar to adore and be with.
