

Dear People of St. Mark's...

I will be away for two weeks this Fall: From October 18-25 I will be on my yearly vacation to South Carolina with a bunch of old guys. My second period of absence will be November 10-19 when I will be a chaplain on a pilgrimage to the Holy Land. Just to let you know, by Canon Law, priests are allowed 4 weeks holidays per year (3 weekends). Normally I would not be away two weeks in the Fall, it just happened that way.

During my absence, **Fr. Zygmunt Baranowski** will cover both weekends and several weekdays for daily Mass. He is an old friend, a recently retired priest residing in the Kitchener area. He is a very holy man, devout and reverent. I know you will welcome him warmly, as usual.

Two tips for when he is here: Number one, he prefers not to talk a lot before Mass so that he can prepare himself. Number two, he gave the greatest sermon ever preached in this diocese on the Holy Trinity. Invite him to preach the sermon here next year. Don't be surprised if you get a big smile and even a big laugh out of him.

I thank my old friend for covering for me. I think you will be blessed by him – as I'm sure he will be by our good people.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church is a wonderful resource to learn more about Christianity and our Catholic faith. I would like to offer an opportunity to dig into our catechism using the shorter, concise compendium to the Catechism. The format I will use (as I have in the past) is simple and one that seemed to help people in the past. Essentially, we read sections of the texts together, then I will offer comments and ask for comments and questions from those present. I will offer this every other week. Each session will be wrapped up in 1 hour (lasting not one second longer than 1 hour and fifteen minutes in total). Prayer will be part of each session – mostly traditional Catholic prayers. At the first session I will hand out the Catechism (i.e. compendium). There will be a cost for these (about \$15).
