

Fasting can also mean "taking on" an attitude of loving forgiveness, kindness, generosity.

The Bishop has invited us to consider giving \$1 per day of Lent to support the ShareLent collection on April 9 - 10. Our parish has always generously supported ShareLent in the past and your sharing with the poor makes a big difference in their lives.
