SACRAMENTAL GUIDELINES

Recently, Bishop Crosby approved Sacramental Guidelines for the Diocese of Hamilton. Among the guidelines is a change in the age for the Sacrament of Confirmation. Beginning next year young people in Grade 7 will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation. For the coming year this will mean that we will have Confirmation for children in both Grade 7 and Grade 8; then in the years following it will be offered for Grade 7 candidates. To be confirmed one must be a baptized Roman Catholic and have already received the Eucharist for the first time. Candidates who were baptized in other Christian traditions, may be received into the full communion of the Catholic Church through the Sacrament of Confirmation and Eucharist. Young people who are not yet baptized by Grade 7 will be prepared in a program of formation and will then celebrate the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist) in a single celebration.

The new Diocesan Guidelines affirm that preparation and celebration of the Sacraments with children is rooted in the co-operation of *home, school & parish*. Each partner plays an essential role to assist children in their journey of faith. All are called to undertake this mission responsibly and faithfully.

Some changes will also involve the children preparing for the celebration of first reception of Holy Communion. Our goal is to invite parents to make a conscious faith-based decision regarding the celebration of the Sacraments with their children - an obligation they took on when their child(ren) were baptized. More details regarding registration and celebration dates to follow.

Please pray for our young people and their families who will be preparing to celebrate these Sacraments.


BISHOP REDING 25th ANNIVERSARY
