UPDATE ON THE SALE OF 224 MAPLE AVENUE, GEORGETOWN

The Maple Avenue property was recently sold and generated net proceeds of \$1,900,000 to Holy Cross Parish. These funds have been applied to the existing debt on the new church property.

In the 10 years prior to construction of the new church, the parish saved over \$3,000,000 and since opening in February 2011 an additional \$1,000,000 has been applied towards the debt. Combined with the recent sale of the Maple Avenue property, the remaining mortgage of \$6,700,000 represents 50% of the original cost of the new church property. Great strides have been made towards paying down the debt.

Currently we pay approximately \$240,000 in annual payments on the debt and of this amount, \$120,000 is applied in principal with the balance in interest.

On behalf of the Parish Finance Council who provide their advice and expertise I thank you for your continued generosity to the building fund which is applied directly towards reducing the current debt. *Father Cull*
