A parish Penance Celebration will take place on Wednesday, April 9th at 7:00 p.m. Following a brief reflection, 7 priests will be available for individual confession. Confessors who speak Croatian, French, Italian, Polish and Spanish will be present. In order to assist you in preparing to receive the merciful love of God, an Examination of Conscience is available by the main doors of the church this weekend. Please plan to attend this celebration mindful of God's great desire to set us free from sin and share with us the joy of being reconciled to Him and to one another."

ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

During Lent, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will take place on Friday mornings from 9:30 - 10:30 a.m. concluding with Benediction. This is in addition to the regularly scheduled Holy Hour that takes place on Tuesday evenings from 6:00 to 7:00 p.m.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS

Stations of the Cross and Meditations on the Seven Last Words of Jesus from the Cross - Fridays of Lent at 7:00 p.m. The Stations of the Cross provide an opportunity to reflect on the depth of God's self-sacrificing love, to join our sufferings to those of Jesus and to become more sensitive to the needs of those around us. This is a wonderful Lenten devotion for individuals and families. At the beginning of the Stations, I will offer a brief meditation on the Seven Last Words of Jesus from the Cross. The Seven Words have their own particular structure. They begin with words addressed to the Father, find their centre in a cry to the Father, and return to address Him again at the end. Each meditation will conclude by 8:00 p.m.

EASTER FLORAL TRIBUTES

During the Easter Season, it is a fitting gesture to dedicate floral tributes in memory of deceased relatives and friends. These tributes express our faith in Christ's promise of eternal life and help to beautify the church. Forms will be available in the narthex this weekend for all who wish to make a donation. The names of all the deceased will be placed near the altar and your loved ones will be remembered at all the Masses during the Octave of Easter.
