Good Friday, April 19th at 7:00 p.m. Taizé Prayer is a distinctive style of meditative prayer developed by an ecumenical community in rural France. A typical Taizé prayer service incorporates periods of silence with meditative readings from Scripture, prayers of praise and intercession. The use of simple, contemporary short songs or chants, repeated over and over, create a meditative environment and express basic realities of faith which can be easily grasped by the mind and the heart. The result is to gradually move prayer from the head to the heart. On Good Friday, April 19 at 7:00 p.m. Holy Cross will be hosting Taizé Prayer at the Cross - all are welcome to join us to sill our hearts and souls.
