Marriage - Weddings for parishioners are generally celebrated on Saturday afternoons. Kindly contact the Pastor a minimum of one year before the desired date of marriage. Preparation is provided in the Parish.

Tips for minor bone, muscle, and joint injury

According to the Canadian Red Cross, common injuries are fractures, dislocations, sprains, and strains. The steps for caring for this type of injury are the RICE (rest, immobilize, cool, elevate) method. First, make sure the injury is supported and they are in a comfortable position. Then apply an ice pack and elevate the injury. This will help reduce the swelling and pain. Seek medical attention regarding any concerns or call EMS/911 for severe injury.


