Sacramental Information

Baptism - Infants and young children of parishioners are baptized on Sunday afternoons, except during the Season of Lent. Adults requesting baptism, or the other sacraments of initiation should inquire about the RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults). Contact the Parish Office for more information.

Marriage - Weddings for parishioners are generally celebrated on Saturday afternoons. Kindly contact the Pastor a minimum of one year before the desired date of marriage. Preparation is provided in the Parish.

Sacrament of the Sick - Visits to the sick, either at home or in hospital, can be made by contacting the Parish Office. Arrangements can be made for the *Sacrament of the Sick* and for *Holy Communion*. If you are admitted to the Georgetown Hospital please be sure to identify yourself as a "Catholic" at the time of admission.

REGISTRATION FOR SACRAMENTS

Parents of children who will be in Grade 2 or Grade 8 this Fall and wish to celebrate the Sacraments of First Reconciliation & First Eucharist (Grade 2) or Confirmation (Grade 8) must pick up a registration package at the Parish. These packages will be available in the Narthex after Mass beginning today and through the month of September. Note that the "registration form" can only be returned to the Parish at one of the Parent Meetings in October.

SUNDAY 7:00 P.M. MASS

We are considering starting, on an experimental basis, a Sunday evening 7:00 p.m. Mass. It would begin the Sunday after Thanksgiving (October 16) and conclude on Sunday, April 29. A choir will need to be formed to assist with music for that Mass - anyone interested please contact Father Dave at the Parish Office. As a matter of interest, the nearest Sunday evening Masses in our area are in East Brampton, Oakville and Burlington.

GETTING MARRIED IN 2012?

The parish is now accepting weddings for the summer and fall of 2012. Please note that we request one year's notice of marriage in order to complete the necessary steps in the marriage preparation process. Couples planning "destination weddings" must also contact the parish one year in advance. Catholics are required, by Church Law, to be married by an ordained Catholic priest (or deacon) and two witnesses. Couples may visit the parish website - www.holycrossrc.com - and complete the "wedding application" and then arrange to meet with Fr. Dave by contacting the parish office.

It is important to register as a member (or family) in the parish as a sign of your belonging to our Catholic community. If you would like to register please complete the "Registration Form" found at the front entrance of the church.
