DIOCESAN INFLUENZA RECOMMENDATIONS

As you know the Diocese has offered various recommendations to all parishes in light of the concerns over the spread of H1N1 Influenza. Thanks to all our parishioners for their cooperation. The recommendations include the following:

- 1. At the *Sign of Peace* one may simply bow to their neighbours rather than shaking hands.
- 2. The reception of Holy Communion in the hand is recommended over receiving Holy Communion on the tongue.
- 3. Hand wash stations are available in the Usher's Room and the Sacristy. Hand sanitisers can be found at the entrances to the chapel (behind the Sanctuary).
- 4. Sick parishioners are not obliged to attend Mass.

BUILDING PROJECT UPDATE

The Melloul-Blamey Construction Company have begun construction of our new parish church with the necessary site preparation. During the period of construction visitors to the site must report to the Site Office. There is restricted access to the site to ensure the safety of all.

LITURGICAL REVISIONS & TRANSLATIONS

Did you know that the Vatican has been working with the English-speaking Conferences of Bishops on a new English translation of the Order of Mass? Their goal is a more consistent and accurate translation of the Latin text of the Mass (which is the official text). This work of revision is nearing an end and a new "Missal" should be published in 2010 or 2011. This year's "Priest's Seminar" in September will be devoted to study and reflection on the new Order of Mass to help prepare the priests for these changes. It is expected that resources will be prepared in the coming year to assist all of our people in adapting to these changes. You can see some of these changes to the Order of Mass by visiting the American Bishop's website www.usccb.org and follow the link "Church Life and Ministry" to "Liturgy". The texts of the Order of Mass and the Eucharistic Prayer I -IV are located there in a PDF format.

RCIA - Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

This process, through which adults become fully initiated members of our Catholic faith community, will begin again this Fall. If you, or someone you know, is interested in learning more about the Catholic faith and the possibility of becoming a Catholic, please contact Father Dave at the Parish Office. The process involves weekly catechetical sessions, Sunday Mass, and the associated Rites. It is open to unbaptized adults, those baptized in other Christian churches, and Catholics who desire to complete their initiation.




