Baptism - Infants and young children of parishioners are baptized on Sunday afternoons, except during the Season of Lent. Adults requesting baptism, or the other sacraments of initiation should inquire about the RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults). Contact the Parish Office for more information.

Marriage - Weddings for parishioners are generally celebrated on Saturday afternoons. Kindly contact the Pastor a minimum of one year before the desired date of marriage. Preparation is provided in the Parish.

Sacrament of the Sick - Visits to the sick, either at home or in hospital, can be made by contacting the Parish Office. Arrangements can be made for the *Sacrament of the Sick* and for *Holy Communion*. If you are admitted to the Georgetown Hospital please be sure to identify yourself as a "Catholic" at the time of admission.

MESSAGE FROM FATHER CULL

The Season of Advent

While the calendar year begins on January 1st, the Church's year starts with the Season of Advent. Advent has a twofold nature: we look forward to Christ's second coming and we recall His first coming at Bethlehem. Advent is a season of joyful expectation. There is, however, a growing discomfort among many people with the commercialization of Christmas, a sense that we have forgotten the true meaning of the season. In order to recapture the "reason for the Season of Christmas" we are invited to approach Advent in a spirit of humble prayer. The following are some suggestions to help us throughout the Advent Season:

- ► Reflect daily using the parish Advent Devotions booklet by Father Nouwen.
- ► Pray the rosary or another family prayer before the Nativity scene each evening.
- ▶ Prepare for and celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation or Confession. The sacrament is available every Tuesday evening from 6:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. and Saturday afternoon from 4:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. Additional Advent Reconciliation times (with at least 2 confessors available at most of these times): Saturday, December 16th from 9:30 a.m. 11:30 a.m. & 3:00 p.m. 4:30 p.m.; Tuesday, December 19th from 6:00 p.m. 6:30 p.m. & 7:30 p.m. 8:30 p.m.; and on Wednesday, December 20th from 6:30 p.m. 8:00 p.m. There will be no Reconciliation on Saturday, December 23rd.
- ▶ If you put up a Nativity scene during Advent, wait until Christmas Eve to place the figure of the baby Jesus in the scene. Invite the youngest family member to have this honour. Do not introduce the Magi until after Christmas. Set them at a distance from the Nativity scene and move them a little closer to the manger each day leading up to Epiphany.
- ▶ If you send cards, make this a family celebration rather than an obligation. Each card could contain a handwritten, personal note and be signed by all family members.
- ► Simplify the gift-giving process.
- ► Assist "Holy Cross Helps" or another charitable organization.
