Baptism - Infants and young children of parishioners are baptized on Sunday afternoons, except during the Season of Lent. Adults requesting baptism, or the other sacraments of initiation should inquire about the RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults). Contact the Parish Office for more information.

Marriage - Weddings for parishioners are generally celebrated on Saturday afternoons. Kindly contact the Pastor a minimum of one year before the desired date of marriage. Preparation is provided in the Parish.

Sacrament of the Sick - Visits to the sick, either at home or in hospital, can be made by contacting the Parish Office. Arrangements can be made for the *Sacrament of the Sick* and for *Holy Communion*. If you are admitted to the Georgetown Hospital please be sure to identify yourself as a "Catholic" at the time of admission.

Christmas and the Sunday Obligation

If you've looked forward on the calendar you have probably noticed that Christmas Eve falls on a Sunday! So, what does a Catholic do? Our Sunday obligation (an obligation of love for our Lord!) remains to attend Mass on Sunday <u>and</u> for Christmas. This can mean a morning Mass on Sun, Dec 24th and

a Christmas Eve Mass that same day, or it could mean any other combination of ONE Sunday Mass on Dec 23/24 and ONE Christmas Mass on Dec 24/25. You have many options, but for those who have asked, yes, we are still to participated in one Mass for the 4th Sunday of Advent, and one Mass for Christmas! (We will find ourselves in the same situation for New Years as we celebrate the Feast of Mary, Mother of God – same rules apply!)

On Saturday, Dec 16th from 9:30am – 4:30pm we will be hosting our annual Advent Day of Reconciliation. Priests will be available at any time during that window to hear your confession and receive God's beautiful gift of mercy and forgiveness. Bambinelli Sunday - Blessing of Baby Jesus Figurines

For the past several decades, the Pope has blessed both the people and their Baby Jesus figurine from their family nativity set in St. Peter's Square. The blessing takes place on Gaudette Sunday, the third Sunday of Advent. Our parish will celebrate Bambinelli Sunday on December 16/17 at all Masses. All are invited to bring your Baby Jesus figure from your home to Mass that day to be blessed. After the blessing we suggest you take your "bambinelli" home and place it in a gift box, wrap it, and open it as the first gift at Christmas, placing your Baby Jesus figure in the crib.

Rosary Repairs

Do you have a broken rosary lying around that you're not sure what to do with? Well, there's good news! We have a parishioner that has the skills and tools to repair rosaries, and is more than happy to do so for you! There is a box in the narthex titled 'Rosary Repairs' – simply take an envelope from the box to insert the broken rosary, write your name and contact information on it and we will let you know when it's fixed and ready to pick up.

Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

There is sometimes confusion over what the Sacrament of the Sick is. Anyone experiencing serious illness may receive the sacrament, not just those who are close to death. In fact, it is preferable to receive the sacrament early in an illness when the person in ill health can benefit from the healing graces available as they battle their sickness. It is also the case that one can receive the Sacrament more than once during a time of serious illness, so there is no need to wait until the 'last minute' to call the priest. 'Last Rites', as the sacrament is often referred to, is actually the receiving of three sacraments if the person is able - Reconciliation, Anointing of the Sick, and Holy Communion. If you or a loved one have been diagnosed with a serious illness, contact the office to set up a time to receive the sacrament. If it is a hospital emergency (at any hospital, not just Georgetown), the nurses will have the contact information of local on-call priests which you can request.
