#### MESSAGE FROM FATHER CULL

The Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession)

On this Third Sunday of Advent – Gaudete Sunday – we light the rose candle in the Advent Wreath. This colour signifies joy. In the first reading of Holy Mass, the prophet Zephaniah speaks about rejoicing and exulting in the Lord. In our time, one of the most beautiful ways to experience joy is found in the sacrament of Reconciliation or Confession. As Saint John Paul II has written, it is Christ "in whom God shows us His compassionate heart and reconciles us fully with Himself. It is the face of Christ that must be rediscovered through the sacrament of Penance (Reconciliation)."

During the Year of Mercy instituted by Pope Francis, pastors are encouraged to offer an extended period of time for the sacrament of Reconciliation or Confession. Our parish will offer parishioners from the northern zone

of Halton Deanery (Georgetown, Acton, Norval and Milton) all day confessions on Friday, December 18<sup>th</sup> from 9:30 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

As someone who frequents this sacrament of forgiveness and healing, I encourage you to make your peace with God in this graced encounter with the Father of all mercies. There will also be additional opportunities for the sacrament of Reconciliation on Saturday, December 19<sup>th</sup> from 3:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. and on Tuesday, December 22<sup>nd</sup> from 2:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. and from 6:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. Please take some time to look into your heart, to use the examination of conscience provided, to honestly acknowledge the sins for which you ask God's forgiveness, and to place before the Lord the areas of your life in which you desire the Lord's peace. I look forward to celebrating with you the wonderful gift of the Lord's forgiveness.


