SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Baptism - Infants and young children of parishioners are baptized on Sunday afternoons, except during the Season of Lent. Adults requesting baptism, or the other sacraments of initiation should inquire about the RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults). Contact the Parish Office for more information.

Marriage - Weddings for parishioners are generally celebrated on Saturday afternoons. Kindly contact the Pastor a minimum of one year before the desired date of marriage. Preparation is provided in the Parish.

Sacrament of the Sick - Visits to the sick, either at home or in hospital, can be made by contacting the Parish Office. Arrangements can be made for the *Sacrament of the Sick* and for *Holy Communion*. If you are admitted to the Georgetown Hospital please be sure to identify yourself as a "Catholic" at the time of admission.

Sacrament of Reconciliation for Advent

Advent is a traditional time for receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation to prepare ourselves for the coming of the Lord at Christmas. We would normally host an annual Penance Service, but due to gathering restrictions this year we will instead be adding more times to receive the Sacrament. Our regular times are Tues 6:00-6:30pm, and Sat 4:00-4:30pm.

The extra times will be:

Sat, Dec 12 – 9:00am – 4:30pm (all day Confessions) Fri, Dec 18 – 8:00am – 8:45am; 9:30am – 10:30am Sat, Dec 19 – 3:00pm – 4:30pm Tue, Dec 22 – 5:30pm – 6:30pm

Please plan to receive the sacrament at one of these times. As we get closer to Christmas the priests get very busy, and it's not always possible to schedule a 'last minute' appointment for the Sacrament.

CWL News

Face Masks - We have been contacted by a member of the Knights of Columbus, whose company is currently manufacturing customized face masks. The masks are 3-ply, reusable and washable, 100% knitted cotton, with an antimicrobial treatment, and will have the CWL crest. The cost is \$10.00 each. They are also available with adjustable ear loops – the cost for these is \$10.50 each. If you are interested in purchasing one (or more) of the masks, kindly call Leslie Rutherford at 905-877-1176. The money will need to be dropped off at her house. Orders with the manufacturer will be placed once there are a few people who have purchased them. Once the masks have been received, Leslie will call you to arrange for you to pick up the masks at her house.
