*Marriage* - Weddings for parishioners are generally celebrated on Saturday afternoons. Kindly contact the Pastor a minimum of one year before the desired date of marriage. Preparation is provided in the Parish.

*Sacrament of the Sick* - Visits to the sick, either at home or in hospital, can be made by contacting the Parish Office. Arrangements can be made for the *Sacrament of the Sick* and for *Holy Communion*. If you are admitted to the Georgetown Hospital please be sure to identify yourself as a "Catholic" at the time of admission.

#### **ROMAN MISSAL**

It has been an entire liturgical year since the introduction of the 3<sup>rd</sup> edition of the *Roman Missal* and the accompanying changes in responses, prayers and postures at Mass. Happily we have adjusted well to these changes - at the very least it has our attention. Just a couple of handy reminders ...

Responses at Mass - responding to the prayers and invitations at Mass is part of the full, conscious and active participation of the assembly gathered for Mass. To assist all in making the proper responses you can use the Celebrate in Song booklet, your Sunday Missal, or the front cover of the Catholic Book of Worship III.

Invitation to Prayer - when the priest has finished the invitation, "Pray brothers and sisters, that my sacrifice and yours be acceptable to the Lord our God" the people **stand** and then respond together, "May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands, for the praise and glory of his name, for our good and the good of all his <u>holy</u> Church." We sometimes forget the "holy" part.

Reception of Holy Communion - An act of reverence - specifically a bowing of the head - is to be made before receiving Holy Communion. Once the person ahead of you in the Communion procession has received and is walking away from the minister you may bow your head and then present yourself for the reception of Holy Communion. The Eucharistic bread may be received either in our hands or on our tongue. Please consume the Sacred Host in the presence of the minister. You may then, if you wish, receive the Precious Blood from the Chalice following the same steps. Only Catholics who have received their first Holy Communion may receive the Eucharist - however, all are welcome to join us for the celebration.

*Fasting* - we Catholics are encouraged to fast from foods one (1) hour before receiving Holy Communion.
