Baptism - Infants and young children of parishioners are baptized on Sunday afternoons, except during the Season of Lent. Adults requesting baptism, or the other sacraments of initiation should inquire about the RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults). Contact the Parish Office for more information.

Marriage - Weddings for parishioners are generally celebrated on Saturday afternoons. Kindly contact the Pastor a minimum of one year before the desired date of marriage. Preparation is provided in the Parish.

Sacrament of the Sick - Visits to the sick, either at home or in hospital, can be made by contacting the Parish Office. Arrangements can be made for the *Sacrament of the Sick* and for *Holy Communion*. If you are admitted to the Georgetown Hospital please be sure to identify yourself as a "Catholic" at the time of admission.

<u>Christmas Masses – Registration Information</u>

Due to capacity restrictions we are required this year to have you register to come to a Christmas Mass in order to control our numbers. You are asked to register for your free ticket online for the Mass you wish to attend. You will then show that ticket (on your phone or a printout) to one of our ushers to gain admission to the church at Christmas. We are sorry — but if you show up without a ticket at Christmas, you will be turned away at the door. Tickets are now available. Each email address will be allowed to register for 5 tickets. <u>Christmas Mass Registration (For those that don't have computers)</u>

The process of registering will be easiest for both you and the parish if you register online, however we do recognize that there are some of our parishioners that do not use a computer. If this is your situation, ask someone to register for you. If that is still not possible, call the office sometime after December 5th and we will register for you manually.

Christmas Mass Times

Christmas Mass times this year will be: Dec 24 – 4pm, 6pm, 8pm, 12am; Dec 25 – 9am, 10:30am. As mentioned above, you will be required to register if you wish to come. If demand is high, we will look at adding more Christmas Masses.

Sacrament of Reconciliation for Advent

Advent is a traditional time for receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation to prepare ourselves for the coming of the Lord at Christmas. We would normally host an annual Penance Service, but due to gathering restrictions this year we will instead be adding more times to receive the Sacrament. Our regular times are Tues 6:00-6:30pm, and Sat 4:00-4:30pm.

The extra times will be:

Sat, Dec 12 – 9:00am – 4:30pm (all day Confessions) Fri, Dec 18 – 8:00am – 8:45am; 9:30am – 10:30am Sat, Dec 19 – 3:00pm – 4:30pm Tue, Dec 22 – 5:30pm – 6:30pm

Please plan to receive the sacrament at one of these times. As we get closer to Christmas the priests get very busy, and it's not always possible to schedule a 'last minute' appointment for the Sacrament.

CWL News

Face Masks - We have been contacted by a member of the Knights of Columbus, whose company is currently manufacturing customized face masks. The masks are 3-ply, reusable and washable, 100% knitted cotton, with an antimicrobial treatment, and will have the CWL crest. The cost is \$10.00 each. Once the masks have been received, Leslie will call you to arrange for you to pick up the masks at her house.
