#### **Capital Campaign Survey Results**

Thank you for your participation in the *One Heart, One Soul Capital Campaign* survey. The results have come in as follows:

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Choice Votes:

- Lay Pastoral Associate 46.5%
- Debt Reduction 32.4%
- Lighting Retrofit 9.9%
- Air Conditioning Replacement 5.7%
- Sound System 5.6%

Taking into account the ranking of choices (how you selected priorities 2-5), the order remained the same, but showing a strong support for Debt Reduction. Other results worth highlighting are 'Replacing or Fixing the AC' had a strong showing as a number 2 vote, accounting for 24.3% of 2<sup>nd</sup> vote selection. Also of note, Lighting Retrofit had a strong 3<sup>rd</sup> choice showing at 40.85%.

Our Capital Campaign Committee will be meeting again soon to discuss these results, as well as to discuss some other ideas that were put forth. We will be settling on our project priorities soon, and will continue to update the parish on the Campaign planning. Thank you for your participation!
