# ASH WEDNESDAY AND LENT FASTING AND ABSTINENCE

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of *universal* fasting and abstinence from meat for Catholics. The rules for abstaining from meat are simple. All Catholics, 14 years of age and older, may not eat meat on Ash Wednesday or Good Friday as a sign of penance. One may choose to abstain from meat on Fridays throughout the year or perform some act of charity in place of abstinence.

Fasting from food applies to Catholics, in good health, who are between the ages of 18 and 59 years of age. A fast may simply mean eating less food at the times of day we normally eat.

Christian fasting obtains its full meaning when we deprive ourselves of food in order to be more open for prayer, to share more in the suffering of those who are starving and to save money to give to the poor. Fasting among Christians is a penitential discipline intended to open our hearts to God and others, a means of purification and spiritual liberation, a witness of the depth of our faith.

#### **STATIONS OF THE CROSS - Friday Evenings**

The Stations of the Cross will begin at 7:00 p.m. on Fridays. The Stations of the Cross provide an opportunity to reflect on the depth of God's self-sacrificing love, to join our sufferings to those of Jesus and to become more sensitive to the needs of those around us. This is a wonderful Lenten devotion for individuals and families.

#### **SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION** (Confession)

During the penitential Season of Lent, I encourage you to make your peace with God in this graced encounter with the Father of all mercies. Pope Francis so beautifully reminds us: "Whenever we take a step

towards Jesus, we come to realize that He is already there, waiting for us with open arms...How good it feels to come back to Him whenever we are lost! Let me say once more: God never tires of forgiving us; we are the ones who tire of seeking His mercy." There are opportunities for the sacrament of Reconciliation on Tuesdays from 6:00 - 6:30 p.m. and on Saturdays from 4:00 - 4:30 p.m. In addition, a Parish Penance Celebration will take place on Wednesday, March 25<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. with a number of priests available to celebrate the sacrament.

ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT - Fridays in Lent - This Lent, we will have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on Fridays from 9:30 a.m. until 6:45 p.m. in the Sacred Heart Room. It's a great opportunity to drop by to spend some quiet time with Our Lord. You can enter through the Parish Centre doors. Sign-up sheets will be posted asking you to commit an hour of your time during the day to assure someone is always present during this time of Exposition.

HOLY CROSS PARISH LENTEN RETREAT: March 7-11 "Conversion in the Ordinary: Discovering God in Everyday Life" - March 7/8 Weekend Masses: We welcome Father David B. Perrin, Professor at St. Jerome's University who will preach and preside at all Masses the weekend of March 7/8. The homily will focus on the importance of "retreat" - taking time away from the usual routines to focus on our relationship with God, self, others and creation. This will launch our Lenten Retreat 2020. Copies of Fr. Perrin) before and after all the Sunday Masses.
