ORDINARY TIME

Today's feast of the *Baptism of the Lord* draws the Christmas Season to a close in the Church's liturgical year. The Season of *Ordinary Time* begins on Monday and continues until Ash Wednesday (February 18) the beginning of the Lent/Easter cycle.

MESSAGE FROM FATHER CULL

As we celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord this weekend, we call to mind the day of our baptism when God chose us as His own and essentially said to us "I will love you forever". Over the next two weeks we will be offering a retreat day to the grade 7 students in our four parish elementary schools who are continuing to prepare to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation this March. We encourage them to open their hearts to the great goodness of God Who sends them to be His witnesses.

Although Ash Wednesday and the Season of Lent do not begin until the middle of February, I wish to give you a heads up regarding a number of activities that will take place during Lent:

➤I will be presenting in power point format a reflection and meditation on three key passages in the Gospel of John: the woman at the well, the man born blind, and the raising of Lazarus. These three passages were of particular significance to those preparing for baptism in the early Church. As we did with the series by Father Barron on the Person of Jesus as Priest, Prophet and King this past November, the series will be offered on Tuesday mornings and Wednesday evenings.

>Eucharistic Adoration followed by the Stations of the Cross on Friday evenings.

>I am also delighted and excited to share with you that we have ordered a little meditation booklet for each of the days of Lent by Father Barron who has such a beautiful way of teaching the faith.
