

Sacramental Information

Baptism - Infants and young children of parishioners are baptized on Sunday afternoons, except during the Season of Lent. Adults requesting baptism, or the other sacraments of initiation should inquire about the RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults). Contact the Parish Office for more information.

Marriage - Weddings for parishioners are generally celebrated on Saturday afternoons. Kindly contact the Pastor a minimum of one year before the desired date of marriage. Preparation is provided in the Parish.

Sacrament of the Sick - Visits to the sick, either at home or in hospital, can be made by contacting the Parish Office. Arrangements can be made for the *Sacrament of the Sick* and for *Holy Communion*. If you are admitted to the Georgetown Hospital please be sure to identify yourself as a "Catholic" at the time of admission.

ROMAN MISSAL

We continue to do well with the responses. "And with your spirit" presents its challenges sometimes. For the Sunday Masses in the month of January I will be using Eucharistic Prayer II - we used Eucharistic Prayer III for Advent. We'll continue using the Nicene Creed for Sundays until the Season of Lent when we will use the *Apostles' Creed*.

ORDINARY TIME

Now that the Christmas Season has concluded (it ends with the *Baptism of the Lord* observed on Monday, January 9th) we now begin the season of *Ordinary Time*. These Sundays of the year unfold for us the life, ministry, the dying and rising of the Lord. We begin today with the Second Sunday in Ordinary Time. There are five weeks of Ordinary Time until the beginning of the Season of Lent. After the Easter Season we resume Ordinary Time until the Feast of Christ the King.

Green is the liturgical colour of Ordinary Time. It is a symbol of the *hope* that is ours as followers of Christ.

The readings for Sunday Mass this year follow "Year B" of the liturgical cycle and we will hear most of the Gospel of Mark.

TAX RECEIPTS

Income tax receipts for donations made to Holy Cross Parish in 2011 will be mailed before the end of February. Holy Cross Parish is a Federally registered charitable organization, subject to the regulations of the Canada Revenue Agency concerning charities. All identified donations to the parish are eligible for an income tax receipt.

WEDDINGS IN 2013

Couples planning to marry at Holy Cross Parish in 2013 are invited to contact the parish office to make arrangements. We ask one year's notice of marriage in order to accommodate the various aspects of the preparation process. Those planning weddings away from Georgetown are also asked to offer one year's notice - often these weddings involve additional documentation which can take time. Catholics are encouraged to follow the Church's law regarding marriage, namely, that it takes place in a Catholic church before an ordained deacon or priest and in the presence of two witnesses.

Thanks to the leaders & volunteers who offer *Children's Liturgy of the Word* each Sunday at the <u>9:00 a.m.</u> Mass. They resume today. It's not too late to sign up!
