#### Sacramental Information

*Baptism* - Infants and young children of parishioners are baptized on Sunday afternoons, except during the Season of Lent. Adults requesting baptism, or the other sacraments of initiation should inquire about the RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults). Contact the Parish Office for more information.

*Marriage* - Weddings for parishioners are generally celebrated on Saturday afternoons. Kindly contact the Pastor a minimum of one year before the desired date of marriage. Preparation is provided in the Parish.

*Sacrament of the Sick* - Visits to the sick, either at home or in hospital, can be made by contacting the Parish Office. Arrangements can be made for the *Sacrament of the Sick* and for *Holy Communion*. If you are admitted to the Georgetown Hospital please be sure to identify yourself as a "Catholic" at the time of admission.

#### **CHRISTMAS SEASON**

The Christmas Season continues today with the celebration of the *Feast of the Epiphany* - the revelation of the Lord to the nations. Many of our Christmas decorations will be removed from the Church in the coming week as we prepare for the conclusion of the Season with next week's *Feast of the Baptism of the Lord*. The Season of Ordinary Time begins on Monday, January 14<sup>th</sup>. The *Season of Lent* begins with *Ash Wednesday* on February 13<sup>th</sup>. Easter is early this year - Sunday, March 31<sup>st</sup>. The Season of Ordinary Time resumes after Pentecost Sunday (May 19<sup>th</sup>). These weeks are always a busy time in the parish as we celebrate Confirmations (February & May) and 1<sup>st</sup> receptions of Holy Communion (April, May & June) in addition to the feasts and celebrations of the Lent & Easter Seasons!

# FATHER'S NEWS & NOTES ... Sacrament of the Sick

The Sacrament of the Sick can be celebrated <u>anytime</u> one is seriously ill or facing major surgery. It is not reserved to the time of death. We do not have "last rites" which suggest a limitation in an appreciation of the healing ministry of the Church's prayer. When someone is near death there are special prayers of commendation that are used. Please call the parish office if you, or a member of your family wishes to celebrate the Sacrament of the Sick.

### Georgetown Hospital

The priests of the parish and our hospital visitors make regular visits to the sick in the Georgetown Hospital. Kindly be sure to identify yourself as a Catholic so that your name can be given to us when we visit.

## Low-gluten hosts

The parish has "low-gluten" hosts which can be used by those who are dealing with celiac challenges. Please speak with me if you wish to begin using these hosts.

#### Handicapped Parking spots

We have several "handicapped" parking spots near the church entrance. Please note that <u>ONLY</u> people with a valid parking pass my use these spots. Folks who are able-bodied should use the other parking areas. Often those who really need the spots do not have access to them.

### 2014 Weddings

Couples planning to marry in 2014 should contact the parish office. Kindly note that we require <u>one</u> year's notice of marriage to allow time for marriage preparation and the completion of the necessary documents. This requirement also applies to couples from Georgetown who are planning marriage outside the Diocese of Hamilton.

#### Sabbatical

My sabbatical leave will begin with my departure from the parish on Saturday, January 26<sup>th</sup>. I return to Holy Cross on Thursday, May 16<sup>th</sup>. For the most part my time will be spent in Rome, however, I will also do some travelling during this time. In Rome I'll participate in a program for priests offered by the *Pontifical North American College*. This is a grace-filled opportunity for me and I humbly ask your prayers and offer the assurance of my prayers for you. Father Mark Sullivan will offer pastoral care to the parish during my absence. He may be contacted through the Parish Office and he will live in the priest's residence. Thanks in advance to our parish staff for all their support during the time I will be away.

#### **EARLY FRENCH IMMERSION PROGRAM**

The Halton Catholic District School Board will be piloting the implementation of an Early French Immersion Program for students entering Grade 1 in September 2013. All Halton Hills students currently in Senior Kindergarten are eligible to register for this optional program which will run at St. Brigid Catholic Elementary School. Registration for this program will consist of a two-part process; completion of an online registration form, as well as completion of a written registration form in person. #### **PASTORAL LETTERS OF REFERENCE**

Teacher candidates, support staff, and those seeking leadership roles in Catholic schools are required to have a letter from their parish priest offering his support of their application to the Catholic School Board. Pastoral letters of reference are offered for parishioners who regularly attend Sunday Mass and are involved in our parish community. Standard forms for this purpose have been provided by the Diocese of Hamilton and are completed during a personal interview with one of the priests of the parish. Kindly contact the parish office to arrange an appointment. A faith reflection will be provided to the prospective candidate and we ask that it be completed and brought in when the candidate meets with the priest. Please note that there are some situations where it may not be possible to offer a pastoral letter. A lack of church attendance, and/or the pursuit of a lifestyle which may not be in harmony with the Church's teaching may present a situation in which the priest is not able to offer a positive pastoral reference. Our Catholic teachers are in a position to offer a powerful witness to the Catholic faith.
