The children will be dismissed at the beginning of Mass and will rejoin their parents at the time of the preparation of the gifts. #### **CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD**

The *Atrium* has moved from the church basement into the former rectory for the month of January. Sessions will be offered there until the move to the new Church. The new Atrium will open with a special celebration and blessing on Wednesday, February 16<sup>th</sup>.

Clearly there is going to be lots of activity in the parish over the coming weeks. Let's all pull together and help to make the transition smoothly.

#### **ORDINARY TIME**

The Season of Christmas concludes today with the celebration of the Baptism of the Lord. Ordinary Time begins. This is an important period of the Church's liturgical year. Despite its title, many wonderful things can happen during this period. We are called to continue to open our hearts to the mystery of God's love as it unfolds in the Scriptures. This year we will hear the Gospel of Matthew at most of our Sunday celebrations.

The *Season of Lent* begins with Ash Wednesday on **Wednesday, March 9**th. Easter will be celebrated on **Sunday, April 24**th. It is the latest date for the celebration of Easter. Ordinary Time resumes after the Feast of Pentecost - 50 days after Easter.

#### **SCHOOL REGISTRATION & ADMISSION**

The Halton Catholic School Board will receive early admissions for JK and SK later in January. Kindly contact your local Catholic school for information. In Halton Catholic Board all children registering for school must be baptized Catholics (of either the Latin or Byzantine Rite). Children who are not baptized or who have been baptized in another Christian denomination may not be registered for School until appropriate arrangements are made in consultation with the local parish priest. It is generally our habit to only baptize a child when at least one of the parents is a baptized Catholic. Baptism preparation is required along with a commitment to raise the child in the Catholic faith. In this regard we always presume the good will of the parents in making these commitments.


