Arrangements can be made for the *Sacrament of the Sick* and for Holy Communion. #### **RCIA - Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults**

#### **CELEBRATE IN SONG**

Celebrate in Song is the new liturgical resource published by the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops to assist us in receiving the new English translation of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Edition of the Roman Missal. These changes will be fully implemented in our parish (and the rest of the English-speaking world) by the First Sunday of Advent. These books contain the new "Order of Mass" and some additional hymns. A "pew card" will also be placed in the pews later this Fall. These cards will have the peoples' responses for the Mass.
