Celebrate in Song is the new liturgical resource published by the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops to assist us in receiving the new English translation of the 3rd Edition of the Roman Missal. These changes will be fully implemented in our parish (and the rest of the English-speaking world) by the First Sunday of Advent. These books contain the new "Order of Mass" and some additional hymns. A "pew card" will also be placed in the pews later this Fall. These cards will have the peoples' responses for the Mass.
