ORDINATION OF DEACONS

The Bishop of Hamilton Diocese, the Most Reverend Douglas Crosby will ordain six candidates to the *Permanent Diaconate* on Saturday, June 2nd at 10:00 a.m. in the Cathedral of Christ the King, Hamilton. Permanent Deacons are often married men who assist the Bishop in apostolic works of charity and justice around the Diocese. They also assist at Holy Mass, baptisms, weddings, and funerals. The Bishop will also ordain two seminarians to the *transitional* Diaconate. These individuals will continue their studies for the Holy Priesthood in preparation for ordination next Spring. Please pray for these candidates, their families, and for willing hearts to respond to God's call to Holy Orders, and consecrated Religious Life.

It will be an opportunity for us to reflect on our role at Sunday Mass and our reception of the Lord in Holy Communion.
