Construction is progressing very well at our new church site. The peaked roof and flat roofs are in the final stages of completion. All the floor slabs have been poured. And the electrical, plumbing and mechanical finish work is moving along well. In the coming weeks the windows will be installed and work will continue on the parking lots, driveway and curbs.

The residence is nearly completed. Kitchen cabinets are to be installed at the beginning of June.

We do seem to be in a good position to celebrate the blessing and dedication of our new parish church on the Feast of Christ the King (November 21).
