Arrangements can be made for the *Sacrament of the Sick* and for Holy Communion. #### **CONFIRMATION CANDIDATES**

The celebration of Confirmation will take place in our parish on Friday, March 25<sup>th</sup> and Saturday, March 26<sup>th</sup>. His Excellency, the Most Reverend A. F. Tonnos, the Bishop Emeritus (retired) of Hamilton will confer the Sacrament. Please keep these candidates and their parents in your prayers as the celebration draws near.

#### **EUCHARISTIC ADORATION**

We have begun our weekly day of Eucharistic Adoration. The Blessed Sacrament is exposed in the Church from 8:30 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. (during Lent). Come and spend some time in quiet adoration and prayer before our Lord.

### **SERVER TRAINING**

Any child in Grade 4 or older who wishes to become an altar server at Sunday Mass should see Father Dave for an application. Training of new servers will be on Thursday, April 7<sup>th</sup> at 4:00 p.m.

#### **DESTINATION WEDDINGS**

Couples planning to be married in places other than the Province of Ontario should check with the Office of the Clerk at the Town Office to ensure that they are fulfilling the civil requirements for marriage. As far as the Church requirements are concerned, please note that we ask one year's notice of marriage to complete the normal preparation for marriage. Marriages which take place in the Catholic Church, outside of the Diocese of Hamilton, require the completion of additional documentation and the transfer of these documents to the place of marriage. Couples in these situations should consider this additional time requirement in the their wedding plans. It is best to contact the parish office at the time of engagement - BEFORE - halls are booked or airline tickets purchased.

#### **CLARIFICATION ON FUNERALS**

Our Diocesan Office of Liturgy has recently reminded parish priests of the protocol for Funeral Liturgies in the presence of cremated remains. Such funerals have been permitted in Canada since the publication of the *Order of Christian Funerals* in 1990. The Funeral Liturgy rightly takes place in the parish church - either a Funeral Mass or a Funeral outside Mass. It may also take place at the Funeral Home, in which case it is always a Funeral Liturgy *outside* of Mass. Planning the funeral liturgy can be done in advance by consulting our parish office. Specific requests can be kept on file at the Funeral Home if arrangements have already been made with them.

## 3<sup>RD</sup> EDITION OF THE ROMAN MISSAL

Preparations are underway in the Diocese and in our Parish for the reception of the newly revised translation of the 3<sup>rd</sup> edition of the Roman Missal (the texts & responses used at Mass). It is expected that the implementation of these new texts in Canada will take place in Advent. Our parish will offer some workshops to help us prepare for the new texts and to prayerfully reflect on the celebration of Mass. The major changes will involve some of the people's responses at Mass. The new translation also alters the priest's parts significantly.

#### **SEASON OF LENT**

Join us for **Daily Mass** during Lent - Tuesdays at 7:00 p.m. and Wednesday, Thursday & Friday at 8:00 a.m. Daily Mass is a great way to journey through the Season of Lent.

**Stations of the Cross** are prayed publicly every Friday at 7:00 p.m. (Except Friday, March 25<sup>th</sup> - due to Confirmation).

**Sunday Mass** is the full expression of our communion with the Lord and one another.

#### Fasting

Fasting takes many forms. Perhaps we have decided to "give up" something we like for Lent. Whatever we give up we do for the entire period of Lent - including Sundays. Perhaps we give up going out to dinner once during Lent and donate the cost of the dinner to ShareLent.

Fasting can also mean "taking on" an attitude of loving forgiveness, kindness, generosity.

### Almsgiving

The Bishop has invited us to consider giving \$1 per day of Lent to support the ShareLent collection on April 9-10. Our parish has always generously supported ShareLent in the past and your sharing with the poor makes a big difference in their lives.

### Sacrament of Reconciliation

"The light is on for you!" The lights of the Reconciliation Chapel will be on each Wednesday during Lent from 6:30 p.m. - 8:00 p.m. and Saturdays 4:00 p.m. - 4:30 p.m. The Sacrament of Reconciliation - the celebration of God's merciful love will be available during those times.


