Private Prayer in the Church

Unless we are directed otherwise by Public Health, we will be keeping the main **church doors OPEN from 9am – 12pm each day, Monday – Saturday for private prayer**. Unfortunately, we can't open the doors on Sunday, as we would risk attracting a gathering of 50 people or more given this is a usual day of worship. This would contravene the Government of Ontario's imposed prohibition of gatherings greater than 50. Monitor our online channels for the most up-to-date scheduling information.

An Act of Spiritual Communion Prayer

Here is a traditional prayer to use to make an Act of Spiritual Communion in times when we are unable to receive our Lord in the Holy Eucharist:

My Jesus,
I believe that You
are present in the Most Holy Sacrament.
I love You above all things,
and I desire to receive You into my soul.
Since I cannot at this moment
receive You sacramentally,
come at least spiritually into my heart.
I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself
wholly to You.

Never permit me to be separated from You.

Sacrament of the Sick

The Sacrament of the Sick will still be offered for those in danger of death. This of course will be subject to the rules that the hospital and long-term care homes may put in place which could restrict Father's ability to visit. If you find yourself in a situation where a loved one is in danger of death, you can access our emergency line through the parish phone number to contact Fr. Dave, as usual.
