Easter Message from Fr. Dave

Christ is Risen! Truly He is Risen! Alleluia!

Each year, after the penances of Lent, we celebrate the Resurrection of the Lord Jesus who conquers the power of sin and death. To get to Easter Sunday though, we need to experience Good Friday. In each of our lives there is the reality of Good Friday - the reality of the cross - the ways we are called to die to selfishness and self-centeredness and embrace the way of Christ.
