With Ash Wednesday having come and gone, we now find ourselves diving into the Lenten season. The gospel passage this Sunday relates to us the story of Jesus spending 40 days in the wilderness where he fasted and prayed to prepare for his earthly mission. We have this great opportunity to now journey with our Lord for these 40 days of Lenten preparation, committing ourselves to more prayer and penitential practises to renew our focus on Christ. The Ash Wednesday command to 'Repent and believe in the Gospel' should resonate with us over these next several weeks as we delve deeper into the great mysteries of our faith – of our Lord's passion, death and resurrection – reminding ourselves of just how incredible a sacrifice Christ made for you and I so that we may be freed from our sins.

#### **COVID Restrictions: Update**

The Ontario Government has made major changes to COVID-19 protocols. Effective March 1<sup>st</sup>, Churches may now open to full capacity. The ropes have been removed! **Masks continue to be required by all who attend Mass**, with infants and toddlers exempt. Social distancing mandates are no longer in place. The Diocesan vaccine policy for staff and volunteers has come to an end. The practise of those wishing to receive Holy Communion on the tongue coming up at the end in the priest's line remains. Thank you to all for your compliance!

#### **SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION (Confession)**

During the penitential Season of Lent, I encourage you to make your peace with God in this graced encounter with the Father of all mercies. Pope Francis so beautifully reminds us: "Whenever we take a step towards Jesus, we come to realize that He is already there, waiting for us with open arms...How good it feels to come back to Him whenever we are lost! Let me say once more: God never tires of forgiving us; we are the ones who tire of seeking His mercy." There are opportunities for the sacrament of Reconciliation on Tuesdays from 6:00 - 6:30 p.m. and on Saturdays from 4:00 - 4:30 p.m. In addition, a Parish Day of Penance: Saturday, April 2<sup>nd</sup> from 10:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. with a number of priests available to celebrate the sacrament.

#### STATIONS OF THE CROSS - Friday Evenings at 7:00 p.m.

The Stations of the Cross will be offered on Friday evenings at 7:00 p.m. during Lent. The Stations of the Cross provide an opportunity to reflect on the depth of God's self-sacrificing love, to join our sufferings to those of Jesus and to become more sensitive to the needs of those around us. This is a wonderful Lenten devotion for individuals and families.

#### ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT - Fridays in

<u>Lent</u> - This Lent, we will have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on Fridays from 9:30 a.m. until 12 noon. It's a great opportunity to drop by to spend some quiet time with Our Lord. Sign-up sheets will be posted asking you to commit an hour of your time during the day to assure someone is always present during this time of Exposition.
