Lenten Day of Penance at Holy Cross

Lent is always a traditional time of receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation. This year we will be hosting a full day of confessions in addition to our regular times for the sacrament of Tuesday evenings and Saturday afternoons. Our *Day of Penance* will take place on **Saturday, March 20**th **from 10am – 4:30pm.** At least one priest will be available at any time

during that window, with 3 priests available from 10am – 12pm. Mark your calendars and plan to come out that day to receive God's mercy!

One Heart, One Soul Capital Campaign – We have Launched!

We have now officially launched our *One Heart, One Soul Capital Campaign!* We look forward to moving forward with this campaign which will support the goals of our parish, and to also support shared ministries within the Diocese. The amount requested in the letter is a starting point for consideration but it is not meant to be an expectation. Rather, it is an invitation to prayerfully consider a pledge that makes sense for your family. You may receive a call from one of our Campaign Ambassadors over the next week or two to follow up and ask if you have any questions. The volunteers do not know what you have been asked to pledge, they are simply inviting you to participate, and to assist with clarifications about the Campaign. One Heart, One Soul Campaign – Frequently Asked Questions 1. What changes are being made to the campaign process

1. What changes are being made to the campaign process because of the current situation?

The options for parish projects that utilize campaign funds are even wider now and can include efforts to stabilize operating budgets. Pastors and parish leaders are encouraged to further review request amounts and their use to be sensitive to parishioners' changing situations. Also, options have been expanded on how and whether personal visits are conducted. Face-to-face meetings are an important piece of the campaign, but safety is paramount, and a number of alternatives will also be utilized so that every parishioner's situation is handled safely, sensitively and appropriately.

2. Can our parish use the campaign funds to address operating budget problems?

Yes. This applies to all parishes in coming waves that designate the fund for that purpose. Parishes that have already completed the campaign can use their funds only for the projects for which the money was raised. Those parishes' challenges are not being ignored, however. The Diocese has created a separate fund to help parishes with significant operating budget needs created because of the shutdown.

3. Given the concerns about safety, can we do the campaign all by mail?

The Diocese's concerns about safety are among the reasons that the completion of Waves 2 and 3 was delayed for a lengthy period. As we resume, the flexibility built into the campaign processes will give pastors and parish leaders options for adjustments that will allow them to structure their campaigns in a way that promotes safety. This also

takes into account that the campaign is not just about money. There is a significant, positive impact from the "personal" aspect of any parish project, including a campaign. We want the campaign's goals to be effectively communicated, parishioners to have every opportunity to ask questions, volunteers to have a chance to express their support and, frankly, for parishioners to have the chance to simply talk with and get to know one another, albeit over the phone of from a safe distance.
