### **GOOD FRIDAY - Day of Fasting & Abstinence**

Good Friday is a *universal day of fasting and abstaining from meat* for Catholics. Fasting binds those who are in good health and are aged 18 to 59 years. Fasting means that we simplify our food intake - perhaps our portions are smaller. Abstaining from meat is a traditional practice and binds Catholics 14 years of age or older. Along with our fasting and abstaining from meat, we are called to observe the Sacred Triduum - Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday - as days of more intense prayer and reflection on the mystery of the Cross so that we can share fully in the joy of Easter morning.

### **DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS**

On Friday, April 9<sup>th</sup>, Holy Cross Parish in Georgetown invites you to a Day of Prayer for Vocations to priesthood and religious life from 8:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed throughout the day for individual prayer following Mass at 8:00 a.m., and a rosary for priests will be prayed at 8:30 a.m. The Chaplet of Divine Mercy followed by Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament will take place at 3:00 p.m. The day will conclude with Mass at 7:00 p.m.

### **WEDDINGS 2011**

We are currently arranging weddings for 2011 - the dates are filling quickly. If you or someone you know is planning to be married in our parish kindly make arrangements to meet with Father Dave soon. The bride and/or the groom and/or the parents of either must be registered and regularly practising members of our parish. Those seeking to be married in the Catholic Church need to be free of any prior bond of marriage.

### **PASTORAL REFERENCES FOR CATHOLIC EDUCATORS**

### **STAINED GLASS WINDOWS**

It is our intention to have stained glass windows installed in our new parish Church. A local artisan, Bernhard Viehweber is working on the design and fabrication of the windows. This project will likely be completed in 2 phases. Phase 1 will include placing stained glass windows in the 28 windows of the nave facing the intersection of Argyll and Mountainview. We hope to complete this first phase by the time of the dedication in November. Each window will be available for a donation of \$2,300 and a memorial inscription will be placed on the window indicating the name of the donor and the name of the one(s) remembered. Phase 2 will likely be completed after we have moved into the new Church. It will consist of the two large windows flanking the Sanctuary. The theme of the windows is the life that blooms from the cross and embraces us in our lives. We hope to have colour boards on display at the back of the church soon.

Thanks to all who joined us for the informative open house presentation last Saturday evening. The construction project continues to make good progress as the building is closed in and the pace of interior work picks up.

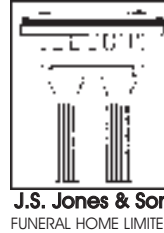
