Marriage - Weddings for parishioners are generally celebrated on Saturday afternoons. Kindly contact the Pastor a minimum of one year before the desired date of marriage. Preparation is provided in the Parish.

Arrangements can be made for the *Sacrament of the Sick* and for Holy Communion. RCIA - Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

The RCIA process will begin again in our parish in September. Anyone interested in becoming a member of the Catholic Church or those who may wish to help form an instructional team are invited to contact the parish office. The team requires individuals who can effectively articulate Catholic teaching using adult learning models. A second team will also be formed to assist with the *Breaking Open of the Word* on Sundays. This team will require people who can lead a faith sharing group based on the Sunday readings. It will meet on Sunday mornings. The RCIA meeting day and time have yet to be established. Training will be provided. The compensation is out of this world!

PAPAL HONOURS

As previously announced, His Holiness Pope Benedict XVI has honoured three priests of our Diocese. Monsignor Harvey Roach has been elevated to a *Protonotary Apostolic* (the highest rank of Monsignor). Father Edward Sheridan, Vicar General of the Diocese, has been named a *Prelate of Honour*; and our former pastor and now Rector of the Cathedral, Father Edward House has been named a *Chaplain to His Holiness*. 
