

Marriage - Weddings for parishioners are generally celebrated on Saturday afternoons. Kindly contact the Pastor a minimum of one year before the desired date of marriage. Preparation is provided in the Parish.

HEALTH NEWS

CPR Workshop on Saturday, May 27 from 9:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. in Cote Hall. This workshop provides the skills and confidence to respond to a cardiac arrest at home, in public or at work. It is designed for everyday Canadians who don't have medical training but who want to learn how to help someone having a cardiac arrest or a choking emergency as well as parents and families with children or infants, who want to be prepared for a choking or other health emergency. This workshop is based on the most up-to-date science from the experts at the Heart and Stroke Foundation. Upon completion of the course, participants will have online access to their Heartsaver CPR AED card. Cost of the course is \$25 per person and includes the workshop and email certification.
