GFORCe2: Update re Syrian Family Sponsorship

GFORCe2-Georgetown Friends of Refugees Committee (2) is a multi-denominational organization who's purpose is to sponsor the relocation of a Syrian refugee family to Georgetown. GFORCe2 members represent the churches of Holy Cross, Norval United, St. Alban's Anglican; Knox Presbyterian and St. John's United. You may recall from our May 7th update that the GFORCe2 committee had been sponsoring the Agobian family. The Agobians were given an opportunity to speed up their move to safety through an offer to move to Australia. We are happy to report that the move has turned out well for them and they are thriving! It is very rewarding to know that we contributed to helping this family survive in Lebanon while waiting for placement. GFORCe2 has identified a new Syrian family which consists of middle aged parents, their son and his wife. They were displaced from their home in Aleppo and are currently living in a small apartment in Lebanon, where they await acceptance of their refugee applications to come to Canada. We are sending them \$300 USD monthly to help assist with living expenses. GFORCe2 has submitted an application for this family and it is currently with the United Church as they are the Sponsorship Agreement Holder (SAH). All space allocations for 2017 have been used; thus we are now waiting for the 2018 allocations from the federal government. Please continue to pray for this family, and the application process. We will continue with fundraising in the New Year - hosting a pub night in January/February.
