DEVELOPMENT & PEACE

A Call To Act - Support Food Sovereignty. Food Sovereignty is the right of people to healthy and culturally appropriate food produced through ecologically sound and sustainable methods, and their right to define their own food and agriculture systems. It puts the aspirations and needs of those who produce, distribute and consume food at the heart of food policies rather than markets and corporations. Threatening this right is the trend towards agrofuels. This fall, Development & Peace will be initiating a campaign in our parish to bring awareness of food sovereignty issues in the Global South to our Canadian government and communities. Attached to this bulletin is a detailed examination of the issues surrounding food sovereignty.

Next week Development & Peace will be handing out action campaign cards after each of the weekend Masses. One card is to send to our prime minister, the other to our local MP, asking the government to focus on this issue, particularly at the next G8 conference. We will collect cards on the spot if you wish and be able to explain any questions you might have.

Development and Peace will be running coffee Sunday at these Masses as well as continuing to sell fair trade products. The purchase of these coffees, teas, sugar, and chocolate helps families sustain a fair income in their communities as well as providing basic needs for their families. 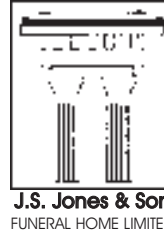
