The World Meeting of Families was initiated by Pope Saint John Paul II in 1994 as a means to strengthen the sacred bonds of the family unit. This conference is held every three years in a designated country and this year, it took place in Philadelphia, USA.

We had the great privilege of attending this conference which hosted many inspiring speakers such as Bishop Robert Barron, Cardinal Luis Antonio Tale, Pastor Rick Warren, Dr. Scott Hahn, Professor Helen Alvare, Mr. Chris Stefanick and Mr. & Mrs. Christian & Christine Meert, to name only a very few. The speakers (including Catholics, fellow Christians from other traditions, Jew and Muslims) discussed many relevant issues confronting families everywhere throughout the world. Throughout this pilgrimage we were inspired by young families who brought their children, single and married people of all ages and in all walks of life, youth participants and religious leaders. The culminating event was the visit of Pope Francis in the city of Philadelphia. No doubt, many of you were able to see the highlights of his visit on television. During the celebration of the Papal Mass on Sunday, September 27 there were approximately 1 million people in attendance. Despite this huge crowd, it was a truly intimate and moving celebration of Holy Mass. What we will remember most from this amazing opportunity of this pilgrimage to the World Meeting of Families and the Papal visit, is the joy, love, hope and kindness which surrounded us throughout the week, the love with which the Holy Father was welcomed and most importantly the great love which exudes from Pope Francis to all the world.
